D. <u>LEGISLATIVE ISSUES AND OTHER INFORMATION:</u>

Keith Penman, Executive Director, reported on the following:

Intake Data: The data shows that most referrals are made due to a delay in speech in children.

Self Determination: An email was received today informing that the Waiver application for the Self Determination Program was summitted to Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services. CMS has 90 days to take action to either approve the application, deny it or request additional information.

Grassroots Day: A group of people, including Gisele Ragusa, a member of this committee, will go to Sacramento on Monday to meet with legislators and share with them about the regional center system.

Caseloads Ratio: SG/PRC had a responsibility to submit data to DDS about the caseload ratios. The data showed compliance in 5 out of 6 areas.

CMS Initial Approval: The Federal Government sent the State a letter on February 23, 2018 informing that CMS will grant California initial approval of the statewide transition plan.
