

#### Comparison of Ages by Ethnicity FY 2018










#### Historic Comparison of No POS % by Ethnicity FY14 ~ FY18







































### Comparison of Per Person Authorizations & Expenditures Data FY 15 to FY 18 All Ages Living at Home by Ethnicity




#### Comparison of Per Person Authorizations & Expenditures Data FY 15 to FY 18 Age 0-2 Living at Home by Ethnicity
