¹Concepts that include ongoing staffing needs should pursue other resources to continue funding staffing costs that extend beyond the approved funding amount. Contracts that include staff or consultants should include how the benefits of additional positions, staff or consultants, will be sustained ongoing. Contracts that include staff or consultants hired for developing employment opportunities or community integration must include measurable goals for progress.

²As appropriate, instead of large passenger vans, providers should consider purchasing smaller vehicles to allow for more individualized community access. Contract milestones must demonstrate increased community involvement.

³Funds awarded for training purposes are intended to support sustainability of the training benefits over time. As appropriate, additional funds may have been added to this concept to support this intention. Regional centers should work with the provider on a plan for sustaining the benefits of the training, considering anticipated changes such as staff attrition. Progress reports must show how the delivery of services has changed since receiving training, and how that change is measured.
