Statewide/ Local Updates:

- The Advocacy Connection (TAC) The next meeting is scheduled for March 28, 2024. Daniel Ibarra, Manager of Appeals & Resolutions, will present on the New Lanterman Appeals & Resolution Process. The number of participants at the TAC meetings has been increasing.
- Grassroots Day April 2, 2024 Grassroots Day will be in-person this year
 after being over Zoom for the last couple of years due to Covid-19. The
 delegation of individuals served, staff, vendors and parents will represent
 SG/PRC, will meet the day before at a briefing dinner with the other regional
 centers delegations to review the information on the talking points and to
 discuss what to expect.
- Legislator Updates There have not been any new changes. The most updated information will be uploaded to the website to encourage the community to contact and build relationships with their legislators.
- Website Updates Sitemap & Transparency Section The beginning phase of the design aspects and the layout is currently being worked on. Staff are discussing areas that could be introduced to the new website that will be interactive with individuals served and their families.
